

ORDINANCE NO. 2724  
(Uniform Regulations for the Control of Drainage)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON, NEVADA, AMENDING TITLE 15.50.010 BY ADOPTING THE UNIFORM REGULATIONS FOR THE CONTROL OF DRAINAGE, REVISED, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 13, 2007, WHICH ARE INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE AND ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE HENDERSON CITY CLERK, ARE AMENDED AND ADOPTED AS THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE MANAGEMENT, DEVELOPMENT, CONTROL AND ENFORCEMENT OF DRAINAGE AND FLOOD CONTROL MATTERS IN THE CITY OF HENDERSON.

WHEREAS, the City of Henderson, Nevada and the Clark County Regional Flood Control District are governmental entities responsible for protecting the general health, safety, and welfare of residents from the hazards and dangers from flooding; and

WHEREAS, a part of said responsibility includes the promotion of sound development policies and construction procedures which respect and preserve the natural and man-made watercourses, protect property owners adjacent to developing or developed land from increased runoff, ensure the safety and utility of public roadways, and decrease stormwater runoff damage to public and private property; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of these regulations ensure the City of Henderson's continued compliance with NRS 543.595, Subsection 3, and Section VIII.A.2 of the Clark County Regional Flood Control District Policies and Procedures Manual regarding the eligibility of funding for activities related to the design, construction, and maintenance of regional flood control facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Regional Flood Control District may, from time to time, revise the regulations to conform to the requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency for participation in the National Flood Insurance Program;


NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Henderson, Nevada, does ordain:


SECTION 1. The City of Henderson hereby adopts the Clark County Regional Flood Control District "Uniform Regulations for the Control of Drainage" as revised December 13, 2007.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section or subsection, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.


