Disposition of Unspent Contributions

Who Must File: Every candidate -- whether elected, defeated or withdrawn -- for a state, district, county, city or township office at a primary, general or special election must dispose of contributions which were received but remained unspent. (It is unlawful for a candidate to spend money received as a campaign contribution for his personal use.)

Where to File: A report of the amount and disposition must be filed with the Secretary of State no later than 5 p.m. on the date due. You may file the report in person or by certified mail. If certified mail is used, the date of mailing shall be deemed the date of filing. Every candidate must send or deliver this form to
