



## DRAFT REDISTRICTING PLANS 2018 Ward Map

With the current ward configuration, Wards 2, 3, and 4 have estimated population more than 5% greater than the estimated population of Ward 1. Given ongoing development, including the Inspirada and Cadence master planned communities, it is expected that this disparity would continue to grow in the absence of a redistricting effort. Three draft redistricting plans have been prepared for your consideration.

**Draft Redistricting Plan 1**

Plan 1 contains fewer ward boundary changes than 2 and 3. Ward 1 moves west through Downtown to I515, while Ward 3 is moved almost entirely north of the 215. Lake Las Vegas moves into Ward 3. Ward 4 remains unchanged. This plan would give Ward 2, which has the most potential for near and long term growth, the lowest current estimated population, potentially delaying the need for future redistricting efforts.

**Draft Redistricting Plan 2**

Plan 2 contains the most significant changes to the ward boundaries. Ward 1 moves south and west toward Gibson. Ward 2 moves entirely west of Gibson while adding the area between Sunridge Heights and Horizon Ridge. Ward 3 adds Lake Las Vegas, the area north of Warm Springs and east of Lake Mead and part of Downtown between Lake Mead and the UPRR. Ward 4 moves north to Warm Springs west of Stephanie. This plan goes further than Plan 1 to increase estimated population for all wards outside of Ward 2.

**Draft Redistricting Plan 3**

Plan 3 contains the second most changes to ward boundaries of the proposed plans. Ward 1 stretches west along Lake Mead and the 215 to Gibson. Ward 2 pushes north above Eastern, while Ward 3 adds Lake Las Vegas and a precinct south of Lake Mead. Ward 4 moves east along the 215. By splitting up the Nevada State College area, West Henderson, Cadence and Union Village and the area along the 215 around Stephanie and Gibson, this plan is both most balanced in terms of current population and may present the best opportunity for balanced growth moving forward.
