Parks&TrailsRules

THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED:

- Fireworks, firearms or weapons of any type
- Overnight parking and camping
- Alcoholic beverages, except by special permit
- Inflatables on grass areas May 1-Oct 1
- Horses, ponies or horseback riding (except at Equestrian Park)
- Trucks, motor vehicles and bicycles on turf or other unauthorized areas
- Climbing on trees, structures or fences
- Staking of tents and other items
- Motorized scooters
- Propane grills
- Skating in non-designated areas
- Dunk tanks
- Hitting golf balls

OTHER RULES AND INFORMATION:

- Persons who intentionally damage or vandalize park property will be prosecuted
- Fires are permitted in park barbecue grills only
- Amplified sound by permit only

•GENERAL PARK AND• TRAIL INFORMATION

WHAT ARE THE PARK AND TRAIL HOURS?

All parks are open daily 6:00 am to midnight. Reservation hours are 7:00 am to 11:30 pm. All trails are open daily 5:00 am to 11:00 pm.

ARE PETS ALLOWED IN THE PARKS?

Pets are allowed in the parks. They must be leashed at all times and are not allowed in the splash pads. Owners must clean up after their pets. Several dog parks are designated for dogs to run free and socialize with other dogs. To find locations near you, please refer to the Park and Facility Guide on page 89. Pets are not allowed at the Bird Viewing Preserve.

WHEN ARE THE SPLASH PAD FEATURES AVAILABLE?

Splash pad features are available May 1 through Sep. 30. Splash pads at Esselmont, Mission Hills, Paseo Vista and Saguaro parks are open from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm. Splash pads at Acacia and Hayley Hendricks parks are open from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm

•PARK RESERVATIONS• CALL 267-5707

THE FOLLOWING REQUIRE A PARK RESERVATION:

- Designated picnic areas
- Use of inflatables, tents, etc. must be used in authorized areas only
- Use of alcoholic beverages (also requires a special permit)
- Special event reservations over 400

CAN PICNIC AREAS BE RESERVED?

The picnic areas (with a few exceptions) are available to all citizens on a first-come, first-served basis unless the area has been reserved through our reservation system. Individuals or groups may pay a fee to reserve a specific picnic area. Water features may not be reserved. All reservations must be made at least two weeks in advance of the event. Henderson-based companies and residents may reserve picnic areas up to 180 days prior to the event. Non-residents may reserve picnic areas 90 days in advance. For a complete list of rules and regulations or an application for reservation, contact us at 267-5707, Monday through Friday, 8:00 am-6:00 pm, or download the form at cityofhenderson.com. All Henderson parks are open to the general public on all federal holidays. No reservations are taken for the observed day.
