Benefits of Inclusion

- Everyone has the right to recreate in an activity of their choice in an environment that is welcoming and supportive of their needs.



- All people learn to grow and develop together.
- Individuals with and without disabilities have fun sharing experiences and building lasting friendships.
- Participants become aware of the differences and similarities between themselves and others. They gain a sense that everyone, regardless of their abilities, has an important role in our community.



Minimum Eligibility To Receive Inclusion Services

- Register at least two weeks in advance
- Adhere to the program's code of conduct
- Be able to tolerate and function, with assistance, in a social setting of 15 individuals or more
- Be able to attend to your own personal care, such as toileting, feeding, etc.
- Do not require a separate area or alternate activity for more than 25 percent of a scheduled program time



Get Started

- Choose an activity and sign up. A complete listing of Parks and Recreation programs is available in *Henderson Happenings* and online at cityofhenderson.com.
- Register for the activity at least two weeks before the start date to allow proper notice for accommodations to be made.
- Although participants may register for a program without a two-week advance notice, accommodations may not be in place.
- Inclusion staff will contact you to gather more information and give you forms to complete regarding your needs and will act as your liaison with the appropriate Recreation Services staff.
- Complete the annual information form (AIF) provided to you and return it within a week of receipt.
- Inclusion staff will periodically observe the program to provide ongoing support.
