Standing Rules of the Citizens Traffic Advisory Board

Adopted November 21, 2002

The Citizens Traffic Advisory Board “Board” is comprised of seven volunteer members who have been appointed by the Mayor and City Council. The purpose of the Board is to receive complaints concerning traffic matters and to recommend to the City Council educational activities and other measures for improving traffic conditions.

1. No person shall address the Board without first being recognized by the Chairman. Thereafter, all remarks shall be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to any individual member. Each person, after being recognized, shall come to the podium or microphone, and give their name and address for the record.
2. Anyone wishing to make a statement for the record shall preface their remarks with “I wish the record to show,” and then proceed to make their statement into the microphone. A written copy of the remarks to be included in the minutes should be provided to the City Traffic Engineer.
3. Individuals making presentations on items not a part of a citizen’s group shall be limited to five minutes.
4. When a group of citizens is present to speak on an item, a spokesperson shall be selected by the group to address the Board. Each presentation by such spokesperson shall be limited to ten minutes. Anyone from a group may be recognized if they have something new or additional information to add to an item. Such additional presentation shall be limited to five minutes.
5. No person other than members of the Board and the person having the floor shall be permitted to enter into any discussion, either directly or through a member of the Board, without the permission of the Chairman.

6. No question may be asked a Board member or member of City staff without the permission of the Chairman.
7. Once the question is called, no person in the audience shall address the Board on the matter without first securing the permission of the Chairman.
8. Anyone wishing to submit an Exhibit(s) for the record on any item on the Agenda is required to provide the City Traffic Engineer or his designee with eleven copies of the Exhibit(s).
