Committee Reports:

1. Curt reports that sign posts are up, trails have been built, the irrigation is fixed, and the flooded trail has been moved.
2. Eagle Projects: December 2, 2006. The sign posts for the trail are ready. December 9, 2006, we need someone to get the tools back and see that the trails are marked for the scouts. Please contact Curt.
3. Nevada Conservation Corps: The Corps has proposed to do the following projects in January/February/March 2007:
  - a. Build a trail head on the south side of the Wash for residents there to have an entrance to the wash.
  - b. Remove new growth of the tamarisk and chip the old cuttings for mulch.
  - c. Fix the erosion on the trails and place mulch and plants along the trails.
  - d. Place "rock drops" to help with the erosion on the banks.The money is available from the fine imposed on the City of Henderson for the sewer leak.
4. Alex stated that we need to do a chemistry test for the tamarisk chips as the leaching of them into the soil could damage the new plants. We can use the chips on the trails.
5. Discussion of trail names included the following suggestions:  
Catclaw Loop  
Eagle Scout Trail  
Channel Trail  
Quail Loop  
Roadrunner

Bench area names suggested are:

Catclaw Cove

Quail Hollow

Considering naming the benches after the Eagle Scout who did the project.

6. Curt will contact the HOA on the south side of the Wash to let them know that the Conservation Corps will be building a trail head on their side.
7. Type II gravel would be a possibility for creating smooth trails for walking.
8. Discussion was held on the future around the Arroyo Grande Sports Complex. Southern Nevada Public Lands money to build a primary trail from there to Pebble. Also may build a trail head just east of Pecos Boulevard for access to the Wash.
