Benefits of Inclusion

- Everyone has the right to recreate in an activity of their choice in an environment that is welcoming and supportive of their needs.



- All people learn to grow and develop together.
- Individuals with and without disabilities have fun sharing experiences and building lasting friendships.
- Participants become aware of the similarities and differences between themselves and others. They gain a sense that everyone, regardless of their abilities, has an important role in our community.



Minimum Eligibility To Receive Inclusion Services

- Register at least two weeks in advance.
- Must have a diagnosis or disability to receive accommodations, if needed.
- Adhere to the program's code of conduct, even with modifications in place.
- Be able to tolerate and function, with assistance, in a social setting of 15 individuals or more.
- Be able to attend to their own personal care, such as toileting, feeding, etc.



- Do not require a separate area or alternate activity for more than 25 percent of a scheduled program time.

Get Started

- Register for the recreation program of your choice. If you or your participant has a special need or disability that requires special accommodations, please contact Therapeutic Recreation & Inclusion Services.
- Contact the Recreation Services supervisor at least two weeks before the start date to discuss the details or features of the program. Although participants may register without a two-week notice, accommodations may not be in place.
- Complete an annual information form and return it within a week.
- The Recreation Services supervisor contacts Therapeutic Recreation & Inclusion Services (if necessary) to discuss the type of support needed to accommodate you or your family member.
- Therapeutic Recreation & Inclusion Services works cooperatively with recreation staff and the family to determine which accommodations best support the individual.
- You or your family member start the program with inclusion support(s) in place, if needed.
- Our staff members periodically observe the program to provide assistance and answer any questions.
- Communication between Therapeutic Recreation & Inclusion Services staff, Recreation staff and the individual and/or family is maintained continuously throughout the cooperative inclusion process.
