

Teens-N-Training

The City of Henderson Parks and Recreation Department's Teens-N-Training (TNT) junior leader program trains teens to become future recreation leaders and provide assistance for our summer programs. This program encourages self-confidence in teens and develops communication and leadership skills.

Responsible teens (ages 14 and 15) willing to make the commitment for an entire program session will be placed based on their skills, interests, availability, and location preference. All assignments provide training, the opportunity to work with children and the chance for teens to develop their leadership abilities. Summer programs using the Teens-N-Training program are Kids Zone and Summer Fun. For more information, call 702-267-4040, \$130 per teen.

PROGRAM RULES

TNT is designed to provide a fun learning experience. Rules must be reviewed by participants and parents. Participants are expected to know and follow the TNT rules. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action and, based on the severity or repetition of the conduct, may result in suspension or expulsion from the activity.

- Participation is contingent upon behavior and how well duties are performed.
- TNTs are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and acceptable manner.
- TNTs are expected to respect the rights of others and to respect the authority of program supervisors, coordinators, etc.
- All electronic devices are prohibited in programs, including hand-held games and MP3 players.
- The use of cell phones while on duty is strictly prohibited.
- Appropriate dress is expected at all times. This includes shirts (provided), tennis shoes, appropriate shorts or slacks, and modest swimsuits (one piece for girls) for swim days.
- Smoking, alcoholic beverages, drugs, possession of weapons, and vandalism are strictly prohibited and will be dealt with according to the law. Parents will be notified of any involvement and will be expected to pick up their teen immediately. Further action including suspension or expulsion from the program will be taken. Refunds will not be available.
- City of Henderson reserves the right of zero tolerance for physical abuse, harassment of any form and abusive and foul language.
- Bring a lunch and drink each day. TNTs are not allowed to leave the program to purchase food.
- Teens unable to report to work are required to notify their supervisor at least two hours prior to their scheduled shift. Parents, please note it is the teen's responsibility to notify their supervisor of their time off requests as well as calling in sick.
- Friends are not permitted to visit while on duty.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Applications are due no later than 6pm on Friday, March 22, 2019. Applications can be dropped off during regular business hours or mailed to Downtown Recreation Center, 105 W. Basic Rd., Henderson, NV 89015.

Interviews will be held April 17-20, 2018, between 2pm and 6pm. We will call to schedule your interview time. Placement assignments are made at the mandatory training set for 8am to 4pm on Saturday, May 11, 2019, at Black Mountain Recreation Center, 599 Greenway Rd.

During the aforementioned training, parents will be asked to attend a short orientation from 8:30am-9am. It is at that time when payment for the program is due. Parents will also learn about the program and how teens will be spending their summer in the program.



HOW TO APPLY

- Fill out the application listing first, second and third program and location choices. Every effort will be made to place you in your first choice.
- Complete all questions, including your preferences for program and site locations.
- Have two respected adults who are not related to you (e.g., teacher, religious leader, coach) write a letter of reference describing your work habits, personality and commitment.
- Once a teen is selected, parents must complete the registration form and submit payment (due at the orientation on Wednesday, May 8, 2019). Participation is \$130 for Henderson residents (add 15 percent for non-residents).
