You were sentenced to random Drug and/or Alcohol testing. The following rules and guidelines outline the routine testing procedures. Make sure to read each condition below and ask any questions that you may have.

1. It is your responsibility to call **702-267-1267** every evening after 8:00 P.M. seven (7) days per week (**Including weekends**). Please listen carefully to the entire message. You will be informed of the date that you will be required to test. If the message states that you are to be tested, then you must report to the "Testing Site" listed above for testing. You are required to report for testing between **1:00 pm and 6:45 pm. Testing is done on a First Come First Served basis and doors will lock promptly at 6:45 pm.**
2. You must have a valid government ID (Driver's License, State ID Card or Passport) and you must bring it to every test.
3. You must bring **all narcotic & mind-altering medications** in their correct container to every test. All medications must be current and not expired. All medications must be verified by valid prescription at the time of testing. Persons testing for only alcohol – this does not apply.
4. If you miss your test date, for any reason, you will not be permitted to make up your test on another date and your testing will be extended. You must report to our office for additional information. Currently, your anticipated end date for testing is: **05/10/2016.**
5. You will be given one (1) hour to submit a sample and at least two (2) opportunities. You may not leave the "Testing Site" after you arrive for any reason. If you leave you will not be granted re-entry and will be counted as a No-Show.
6. You must report immediately to the ASD Office if you miss a test. The only acceptable reason for a no-show would be a medical emergency in which you can verify the miss with hospital documentation (bring this with you) that covers the entire testing time.
7. If you need to leave Clark County, then you must contact Alternative Sentencing at **267-1350** one week prior to your departure to make an appointment to install a Drug Detection Patch and/or SCRAM device. The Patch and/or SCRAM® Device will be installed by an Officer and will not be removed until your return. The cost of the Patch is \$50.00 and must be paid in advance. The cost of the SCRAM® Device is \$15 per day & \$25 set-up. You must also be current with your fees to qualify.
8. Do not consume more than 32oz. of fluids within four (4) hours of testing. You should not consume any fluid within two (2) hours of testing. **Do not drink caffeinated beverages on the day of testing.** Doing so will result in a dilute result, which is a violation.
9. Each week that you were sentenced to DART will cost \$25.00. You will be billed at intake for all weeks ordered and must pay the balance prior to your probation being discharged. Drug confirmation testing is \$30.00 per substance confirmed and is required for all drug tests sent out for confirmation if you deny use of a certain substance and the substance is later confirmed.
10. All samples submitted must adhere to laboratory protocols. Samples containing blood will not be accepted. Please take any necessary measure(s) to ensure that a testable sample is submitted. Failure to do so will result in a violation.
