AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 83 ENTITLED: " AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING CONDITIONS HAZARDOUS TO LIFE AND PROPERTY FROM FIRE; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR ALL OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO."

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SEC. 1. THAT SAID ORDINANCE NO. 83 OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON, NEVADA, BE AMENDED BY THE ADDITION OF SECTION 1-E READING AS FOLLOWS:

"E. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON, FOR THE PURPOSE OF BURNING GARBAGE, RUBBISH, DEAD ANIMALS OR DIRT, TO KINDLE OR MAINTAIN ANY BONFIRE OR KNOWINGLY TO FURNISH THE MATERIALS FOR ANY FIRE, OR TO AUTHORIZE ANY SUCH FIRE TO BE KINDLED OR MAINTAINED IN ANY GARBAGE OR RUBBISH RECEPTACLE, OR ON ANY STREET, ALLEY, ROAD, LAND OR PUBLIC GROUNDS OR UPON ANY PRIVATE LOT, UNLESS A WRITTEN PERMIT TO DO SO SHALL FIRST HAVE BEEN SECURED FROM THE CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT RUBBISH MAY BE BURNED IN AN INCINERATOR DULY APPROVED BY BOTH THE FIRE CHIEF AND THE BUILDING INSPECTOR."

SEC. 2. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FORCE AND EFFECT UPON ITS FINAL PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS IN THE NEXT SECTION PROVIDED.

SEC. 3. THE CITY CLERK AND THE CLERK OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON SHALL CAUSE THIS ORDINANCE TO BE PUBLISHED ONCE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING ITS FINAL READING AND ADOPTION, IN THE HENDERSON HOME NEWS, A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION, PUBLISHED IN THE CITY OF HENDERSON.
