

ORDINANCE NO. 610

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE NATIONAL FIRE CODES, 1976 EDITION, THE FIRE PROTECTION HANDBOOK, 1969 EDITION, THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE, 1976 EDITION, THE LIFE SAFETY CODE, 1976 EDITION, AND THE GRADING SCHEDULE FOR MUNICIPAL FIRE PROTECTION, 1974 EDITION, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 395 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HERewith, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO."

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 536 and all other ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to revive any ordinance or part thereof heretofore repealed.

SECTION 2. The following codes, standards and schedules, copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk of Henderson, being marked and designated as:

- a. National Fire Codes, 1976 Edition, as sponsored and published by the National Fire Protection Association, excluding Sections 101-1 thru 101-124 (Life Safety Code, 1976 Edition) as contained in Volume 9 thereof.
- b. Fire Protection Handbook, 1969 Edition, as sponsored and copyrighted by the National Fire Protection Association.
- c. Uniform Fire Code, 1976 Edition, as sponsored and copyrighted by the International Conference of Building Officials and Western Fire Chiefs Association.
- d. Life Safety Code, 1976 Edition, as sponsored and copyrighted by the National Fire Protection Association.
- e. Grading Schedule for Municipal Fire Protection, 1974 Edition, as promulgated by the Insurance Service Office, Municipal Survey Service.

are hereby adopted by reference as a part of this ordinance and designated as the Uniform Fire Codes, Standards and Schedule of the City of Henderson and by said designation and reference are adopted and made a part hereof the same as if fully set forth herein, said adoption to include all appendices and indexes to said Codes.

SECTION 3. Violation - Penalty. Any person violating any of the terms and provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a term not to exceed six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment; and shall subject the permittee and licensee to have his permit and license revoked, canceled and annulled; and any person being adjudged guilty of a violation of this chapter, or any of the provisions thereof, in the discretion of the City Council, be denied a permit or license thereafter.

SECTION 4. Severability Clause. If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. A copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the City Clerk and notice of such filing shall be published once by title in the Henderson Home News, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Henderson, at least one (1) week prior to the adoption of said Ordinance and following approval shall be published by title (or in



full if the Council by majority vote so orders) together with the names of the Councilmen voting for or against passage for at least one (1) publication before the Ordinance shall become effective.
