





CONTRIBUTIONS

Report Due: April 22, 1991

These contributions must be divided into two categories: Those contributions received during this report period that have a value of less than or equal to \$500 and those received this period that have a value greater than \$500. The candidate should not include cumulative totals in the greater than \$500 section, as these totals are itemized on page 3 of this report.

Contribution Defined. NRS 294A.007 "Contribution" means a gift, loan, conveyance, deposit, payment, transfer or distribution of money or of any thing of value other than the services of a volunteer, and includes the payment by any person other than a candidate of compensation for the personal services of another person which are rendered to a candidate without charge to the candidate.

COMMENTARY: IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS MAY INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO anything of value which is given to the candidate without charge to the candidate, but which has an identifiable value. The donor must identify the value of the contribution and the candidate must report that as an in-kind contribution.
