

ORDINANCE NO. 3722

(Amend Henderson Municipal Code Chapter 2.50 – City Boards and Commissions)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON, NEVADA, TO AMEND CHAPTER 2.50 – CITY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS - OF THE HENDERSON MUNICIPAL CODE, DISSOLVING THE COMMISSION ON TOURISM.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3211 was adopted on September 2, 2014, and Ordinance No. 3397 was adopted on May 2, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the functions for which the Commission on Tourism was originally established may be performed by other advisory boards, and the Commission on Tourism is to be dissolved; and;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Henderson, Nevada, does ordain:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2.50 – Advisory Boards is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2. Section 2.50.355 – Commission on tourism is hereby amended as follows:

2.50.355 Reserved– ~~[Commission on tourism]~~.

- A. ~~Establishment. There is established the commission on tourism.~~
- B. ~~Purpose. The purpose of the commission shall be to advise and make recommendations to the city council on subjects pertaining to tourism, through the director of economic development and tourism, who will also serve as the executive director of the commission on tourism within the limits of the means provided. The commission shall not recommend any expense or indebtedness for any program beyond the funds appropriated to the commission on tourism budget. The commission serves to market and promote the Henderson Events Center and city of Henderson and provides leadership in maintaining and enhancing its good reputation and the city of Henderson as viable cultural, visitor and convention destinations.~~
- C. ~~Membership. The commission shall consist of nine members that may be selected from, but need not be limited to:~~
 - 1. ~~One member who is a representative of the financial community.~~

2. Two members who are representatives of the hotel and/or casino industry.

3. Two members who are representatives of the general business community.

4. One member who is a representative of the chamber of commerce.

5. Two members who are representatives of the arts/tourism industry; and

6. One member who is a representative of the general public.

D. Term. Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, the term of office for each member shall be four years. Terms shall be staggered so that the terms of four members expire during the same year, and the terms of the remaining five members expire in an alternating year.


Terms expiring shall do so on June 30. The same commission member shall not serve as chair for more than two consecutive terms. The term for chair is two years.

E. Meetings; bylaws. The commission shall adopt bylaws establishing meeting times and procedural rules necessary for the efficient conduct of its business.]

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, provision or portion of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or provisions of this Ordinance or their applicability to distinguishable situations or circumstances.




