

RESOLUTION NO. 4409
(Donation of Surplus Equipment)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON,
NEVADA, AUTHORIZING DONATION OF SURPLUS PROPERTY TO
SOUTHERN NYE COUNTY SEARCH & RESCUE, INC.

- WHEREAS, the City of Henderson is the owner of Unit 5603, a gasoline powered 2007 Chevrolet 2500 Crew Cab 4x4 truck, Serial Number 1GCHK23K87F542444, Asset Number 34647, with 89,893 miles of use ("Unit 5603"); and
- WHEREAS, Unit 5603 had been in use by the Henderson Police Department and was recently retired from use; and
- WHEREAS, the City has declared Unit 5603 to be at the end of its useful life thereby making it a surplus asset; and
- WHEREAS, the City received a request from Southern Nye County Search & Rescue, Inc., a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization seeking a vehicle donation of a Chevrolet pickup truck to aid in their search and rescue operations; and
- WHEREAS, Southern Nye County Search & Rescue, Inc., requested a donation of surplus property to be used as part of their search and rescue operations due to the fact that Southern Nye County Search & Rescue, Inc. was down to two (2) vehicles and is having trouble meeting the need for search and rescue; and
- WHEREAS, the donation of the surplus property to Southern Nye County Search & Rescue, Inc. will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City of Henderson by increasing safety in outdoor and wilderness recreation opportunities in the area; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 268.028, the City of Henderson may donate surplus equipment to a charitable organization; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Henderson, Nevada, that:

- SECTION 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct in all respects.
- SECTION 2. The City of Henderson hereby donates surplus equipment, namely Unit 5603, a gasoline powered 2007 Chevrolet 2500 Crew Cab 4x4 truck, Serial Number 1GCHK23K87F542444, Asset Number 34647, with 89,893 miles, to Southern Nye County Search & Rescue, Inc.
- SECTION 3. The officers and employees of the City of Henderson be authorized and directed to do, or cause to be done, all acts and things necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution and the transfer of ownership of the surplus equipment.
- SECTION 4. The Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
