- ◆ Crisis Intervention
- ◆ Safety Planning
- ◆ Advocacy and Support
- ◆ Information and Referrals
- ◆ Court accompaniment, emotional support, information and guidance through the court process - criminal cases (felony and misdemeanor), Temporary Protection Order court hearings, etc.
- ◆ Assistance filing for Victims of Crime Compensation Program for repayment of **qualified** crime related expenses - medical bills, counseling, income loss, etc.
- ◆ Help in filling out, processing and filing Temporary Protection Order applications
- ◆ Keep victims updated on the status of the criminal case

If you are a victim or witness to a crime, the Victim Witness Program is designed to provide services to you and your family, while you are involved in the criminal justice system.

The Henderson Police Department provides both a Victim Witness Advocate and a Domestic Violence Advocate to ensure that your needs are met and your rights, as a victim, are upheld.

Our advocates will work one-on-one with you to identify and provide appropriate resources, depending on your needs.
