



HENDERSON FIRE DEPARTMENT STATION 81

STATION:

- 4.44-acre parcel at 1600 S Boulder Hwy. near Racetrack Rd.
- More than 24,000 square feet
- Three extra-long apparatus bays
- Initial staffing will include one engine and one rescue
- Equipment and supply storage
- Accommodations for up to 12 firefighters, including one Battalion Chief
- Fitness room and classroom
- 10,000 sf fire warehouse will serve as the central distribution for all fire department equipment and medical supplies. The warehouse will feature a loading dock and high-pile storage.

SERVICE:

- Currently more than 32,800 residents in the service area
- Within the next five years, the number of residents is expected to grow to 34,200, and to 38,750 total by 2040
- In 2023, this area experienced 4,091 calls for service
- Calls are projected to rise to more than 4,800 calls per year by the end of 2028

CONSTRUCTION FACTS:

- Replacing current Station 81 located at College Drive and Horizon Drive
- Adaptive reuse of the former Camping World location
- Designed by Leo A. Daly
- The Whiting-Turner Contracting Company is the General Contractor
- Construction budget: \$11.5 million
- Estimated completion is Summer 2025
- The last HFD station was Station 87 in Cadence, completed in December 2022. Station 92 at Larson Lane and Via Centro is currently under construction.

DISTRICT 81 CHARACTERISTICS:

- Council Ward I
- Geographically the largest Henderson Fire Department District, covering 19.9 square miles
- Serves portions of the Boulder Hwy and I-11/US-95 corridors
- Service area includes Railroad Pass Casino
- A portion of Union Pacific R.R. runs through the district
- First-in mutual aid to Boulder City
