- Emergency Management: helped organize Emergency Support Plans, prepared 1,500 Captain Kit activity bags used to teach 200+ kids about Emergency Preparedness, and resourced over 1K residents with preparedness information during community outreach events
- Fire: assisted with showing 10 Fire Stations for public events enabling 5,000+ citizens touring facilities and meeting meet firefighters: taught 300+ residents basic lifesaving skills through Community LifeSaver and LifeRide CPR certification courses
- Human Resources: captured 759 photos of volunteer activities supporting city programs, accomplished 2,000+ administrative tasks, filled 20,000+ files, helped host first ever Volunteer Management Conference attended by 27 volunteer leaders from 23 valley organizations

HENDERSON EMPLOYEE VOLUNTEER PROGRAM (EVP)

Our employee volunteer program saw 264 Team Henderson members along with their families and friends gave 979 hours towards 20 events supporting 19 community organizations. Highlights include:

- Distributed back-to-school supplies to 146 foster kids
- Organized and prepared 2,995 pounds of donated food for local food pantry distribution
- Led end of year field day health and wellness activities for 730 elementary school kids
- Packed 6,300 swag bags in preparation of Inaugural Las Vegas Marathon event
- Supported three Nevada STEAM education initiatives; 49 teams with 412 participants competed robotics events
- Served and packed 200+ meals for homeless and families in need
- Collected 900+ pet supply items and 1-ton of food to support animal shelter needs
- Hosted 576 foster care kids for Back-to-School and Holiday events
- Served as merchant vendors for 301 teens during a real-world financial education event
- Assembled 2,700 lunch bags to feed kids in need over the weekend
- Cleaned 6,300 gently used books to be distributed to youth literacy programs across Nevada

PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT

- Helped with logistics for six 5K and Family Fun events supporting 1,800 participants
- Supported 18 trail and preserve clean-up events removing several tons of debris
- Reported 136 incidents of graffiti, desert dumping, and trail damage for action ensuring safety for 3,700+ trail visitors
- Completed 82 Bird Viewing Preserve (BVP) camps, school field trips, and site support projects
- Hosted two Eagle Scout projects: build/installation of new home for BVP's "Tino the Tortoise" and cleared invasive plant species from seven viewing bench areas.
- 247 coaches mentored 1,045 local youth through baseball/softball, basketball, and soccer sports programs.
- Led a veteran focused Adaptive Recreation Pickleball Program hosting 26 events that served 29 disabled heroes
- Knitting, Quilting, and Crochet groups created and donated 1,191 items such as hats, sweaters, blankets, gloves, etc. to 19 community veteran, children, women, and other organizations supporting clients in need
- Started five brand new programs and events driving participation from 3,062 seniors
- Served 125,514 meals to the seniors in the community

POLICE DEPARTMENT (ANIMAL CARE & CONTROL)

- Participated in 19 community events supporting residents and underserved community members
- Sorted and distributed 192 Strangulation Resource Kits used to support victims of domestic violence
- Collected 360 jackets, 40 blankets, 75 toys for annual "Coats for Kids" event
- Unpacked and organized Back-2-School supplies, lunch totes, and backpacks for 3,000 kids
- Wrote 1,132 citations/warnings and 446 Thank You's in support of handicap parking enforcement
- Helped closed 121 missing persons (adult/juvenile) cases
- Supported 1,246 cats, 1,344 dogs and 317 critter adoptions
- Led seven adoption and special events for shelter pets
